

Virginia Postsecondary Business Teacher of the Year Award

After establishment of the Virginia Postsecondary Business Teacher of the Year Award by former Virginia Tech Chapter of Delta Pi Epsilon, now Virginia Chapter, Delta Gamma, a national honorary professional graduate society in business education, VBEA makes an annual award to honor an outstanding postsecondary business teacher in Virginia. The award is presented at the annual business and information technology summer conference.

All postsecondary business teachers in Virginia, including individuals in community colleges, colleges and universities, and private business schools are eligible for the award. It is not necessary that the nominee be a member of Delta Pi Epsilon or hold a master's degree.
