

Virginia Postsecondary Business Teacher of the Year Award

3. Nominee's Educational Background
 - a. College (s) attended
 - b. Degree (s) received
 - c. Additional course work (if applicable)
4. Evidence of Outstanding Teaching
 - a. Innovative and creative activities, programs, projects
 - b. Educational materials developed
 - c. Interest in and concern for students
5. Contribution to Business Education
 - a. Membership and participation in professional organizations
 - b. Phi Beta Lambda responsibilities (if applicable)
 - c. Involvement in workshops, conferences, etc.
 - d. Other contributions
6. Recommendations
 - a. No more than six supporting documents may be submitted
 - b. Comments from administrators, supervisors, fellow teachers, business people, students, and other citizens in the community may be submitted.
